





Helpdesk



Continuous technical support to SIGNs via fully operational country-specific Helpdesk experts (over 3.700 requests)

Rising number of monitoring reports by SIGNs

+167 SE(C)APs and +84 monitoring reports during phase 2



31 best cases and practices from Eastern Partnership region developed and published on the website

Participation in CoM EU / GCoM development process of new common reporting framework

Monitoring and reporting on activities of CNCs, CTCs & CSs



Adaptation and translation of JRC methodological guidelines on SECAP development for EaP signatories

Brochure on typical mistakes developed based on the analysis of 134 submitted SEAPs/ SECAPs

Thematic training workshops



CoM East III: Overview




6 strategic objectives:

- Stronger <u>focus on regional CoM East identity</u> within GCoM initiative, with continued integration of CoM into the national systems
- Continued and enforced provision of dedicated <u>targeted support and</u> <u>capacity building</u> to existing and potential SIGNs, as well as CNCs, CTCs and CSs
- Direct and dedicated support to <u>municipal energy & climate</u> <u>projects</u>
- Continued effort to create more favorable <u>networking opportunities</u> for SIGNs and involvement of a wider range of stakeholders
- More rigorous and cutting-edge <u>communication</u> on climate and energy issues with focus on civic engagement, especially youth and women
- More emphasis on empowerment of civil society within the CoM www.eumayors.eurricular on the role of women and youth in climate actions www.com-east.eu

CoM East III: Overview







WP1. Secretariat



Tasks:

- ✓ Strengthen CoM East Secretariat's management structure
- ✓ Improve management and monitoring system for signatories
- ✓ Enhance synergies with key stakeholders at national level and policies harmonisation
- ✓ Liaise with GCoM and CoM EU Secretariats, JRC, EU and international initiatives
- ✓ Upgrade and improve CoM East web portal and Extranet

- ✓ Mid-term CoM East strategy and 4 annual plans
- √1 Secretariat Board Meeting per year
- √ Regular meeting of key stakeholders within CoM clubs and/or MDCPs
- ✓ Updated CoM East web portal and Extranet
- ✓ Recommendation papers, reports





WP2. Capacity building & Trainings



Tasks:

- √Assess the capacity building needs of SIGNs, CNCs, CTCs, CSs and monitoring of impact
- ✓ Develop country specific training programmes
- ✓ "Train-the-trainers" workshops for the Secretariat experts
- ✓ Capacity building events for signatories, CNCs, CTCs, CSs and key stakeholders (including new topics like green infrastructure and nature-based solutions, green procurement, energy poverty and energy access, optimised heat supply, urban transport...)
- ✓ E-learning platform

- √1 needs assessment and 6 country-specific training programmes / year
- ✓ Over 100 capacity building events (trainings, workshops, webinars)
- ✓ New e-learning tool is developed



WP3. Helpdesk



Tasks:

- ✓ Operate the national Country Helpdesks
- ✓ Organize central technical support for national Country Helpdesks
- ✓ Develop and adapt technical materials and guidelines for SIGNs, CTCs, CNCs, CSs and other stakeholders

- ✓ Fully operational Helpdesk services are established in each EaP country
- ✓E-library for CoM SIGNs in national languages, FAQ section is updated on the website
- ✓ Database of SIGNs, CNCs, CTCs, CSs
- √25 case studies
- √4 thematic leaflets
- ✓ Benchmark databases for BEI/RVA, mitigation and adaptation measures



WP4. Technical assistance



Tasks:

- √ Raise awareness of SIGNs on available financial sources and mechanism.
- ✓ Assist SIGNs with better medium-term investment planning and SECAP implementation
- ✓ Support SIGNs in the development of bankable projects
- ✓ Organize project bundling
- ✓ Match SIGNs with donors, national and international finance institutions, private sector
- √ Foster the establishment of Project Implementation Units (PIUs)

- ✓ Interactive country-specific funding guide for signatories in 6 national languages
- √ 3 thematic publications
- √ 30 medium-term investment programmes and/or projects portfolio for various sectors
- ✓ 200 projects developed and uploaded to the online tool (project pipeline)
- √ 12 bundles in form of teasers
- √ 2 match-making meetings per country per year
- √ 5 study visits and 4 PIU country-based networks





WP5. Networking



Tasks:

- ✓ Organize and moderate the Municipal Development Coordination Platforms (MDCPs) / National Covenant of Mayors Clubs
- ✓ Organize annual CoM East national conferences and signing ceremonies
- ✓ Expand the CoM East EU study visits and staff exchange programme
- ✓ Organize the CoM East launch and final conferences and multi-country networking events
- ✓ Facilitate participation of CoM East signatories in European and international events

- ✓ Launch and final events
- ✓ 2 MDCP/Mayors clubs' meetings and 1 national conference per year.
- ✓ 2 multi-country Mayors campus on climate change adaptation
- ✓ 25 study visits (18 technical, 4 mayors, 3 staff exchanges)
- ✓ 2 municipal practitioners' group meetings and 2 CoM East representatives in meetings, initiatives and conferences of GCoM, CoM EU, EUSEW



WP6. Communication



Tasks:

- ✓ Develop a communication and visibility strategy incl. communication tools
- ✓ Promote CoM East at international / country level during prestigious events
- ✓ Prepare tools to engage the population (especially women & youth) into local climate action
- ✓ Support signatories in organising EU Sustainable Energy / Green / Mobility Weeks
- ✓ Organize communication training workshops

- ✓ Communication strategy
- ✓ Updated website, project social media accounts on Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, YouTube
- √ 2 newsletters per year
- √ 10 short motivational videos for social media, 1 longer country-specific video to visualize CoM progress, 1 generic video for high-level event
- ✓ Information kits for journalists and press folder in six languages
- √ 100 cities supported with the organisation of EU Sustainable Energy/Green/Mobility Weeks
- 1 communication training per year/ country
